Private Sessions of our Regular Workshops

Fee: \$5,000 for up to 18 participants; additional participants \$300/person

One of our [regular workshops](#) offered just for your group on dates of your choosing. Workshop options are COIL Foundations, COIL Elements, COIL Design, or COIL Coordinator – visit our professional development page for more information on each of these workshops.

Maximum number of participants: 30

Customizable In-Person and Online Workshops

The following workshops are offered only for private groups. Both can be offered in-person or online.

Introduction to COIL Workshop (half-day)

Fee: \$5,000 plus travel costs if in-person and overnight is required for presenter

- If in-person, a one-hour COIL information/overview presentation designed for a general audience of 6-20 people will be included, if desired.

COIL Design Workshop (2.5 days)

Fee: \$12,000 plus travel costs if in-person and overnight is required for presenter

- Maximum number of participants: 20

Bespoke Workshops

Fee: Dependent on workshop scope, length, and number of participants (average range \$5,000 - \$12,000)

We can also create workshops designed specifically for your institution or group. Bespoke workshops can focus on any aspect(s) of COIL – a few potential options are listed below:

- Introduction to COIL Methodology
- Collaboration Design and Implementation
- Administrator/Coordinator Training
- Improving COIL Collaborations
- Assessment and Evaluation

Workshop delivery and length can range from a half-day synchronous workshop to a three-week asynchronous workshop. Please contact us to discuss your needs.

Mentored Campus Implementation (online only)

Fee: \$3,000 per team of 4-6 campus staff

(should include the campus COIL Coordinator, an administrator, and COIL practitioners)

12 hours of strategic planning with experienced administrative staff, faculty, and instructional design mentors, available to each campus team before, during, or after a COIL campus implementation. Mentoring hours can be used to plan COIL curriculum, refine or re-design elements of the strategic process, and/or to support the implementation of COIL projects. Mentoring can also offer support for group dynamics, developing intercultural competence, classroom management, communication issues, reflection, etc.

COIL Collaboration Online Reviews

Fee: \$1,000

Get hands-on feedback from the SUNY COIL Center Director on your COIL collaboration.

The Online Review includes:

- Observation of COIL collaboration activities
- Discussion with COIL teaching faculty and supporting staff (if applicable)
- Discussion with students (if desired)
- Review of syllabi, activities, and communication tools
- Written report and recommendations

COIL Strategic Planning and Implementation

Fee: \$5,000 - \$20,000 dependent on scope of the engagement

COIL Strategic Planning is generally a yearlong engagement, beginning with identifying an appropriate COIL team at the institution. This team meets regularly over the course of 3 months to develop a plan for introducing and scaling COIL at the institution with support from the SUNY COIL Center.

Milestones and a timeline are identified. Implementation support is provided through 90 minute online quarterly check-ins and support meetings. Involvement of 1-2 COIL Center staff for approximately 70 hours total. Generally includes one or two days spent on campus.

Online and/or in-person (additional charge for cost of travel if overnight is required).

Strategic Planning and Implementation Includes:

- Identifying a COIL implementation team from appropriate areas of the institution
- Readiness and needs assessment
- Asset mapping
- Alignment and articulation of COIL benefits to the Institution's Strategic Plan
- Faculty outreach planning
- Support for development of timeline, milestones and written plan
- Quarterly check-in and support meetings
